Dear Friends of CIS,

"Springing Forward" by Rev. Christine Emmerling D.D.

There is an old saying "March comes in like a lion and goes out like a lamb." We are reminded that the month of March is the transition in seasons from winter to spring. The Spring Equinox celebrated on March 20, 2025, marks this transition. For many cultures this is also a beginning of a new year. For us here in California, we have flowers and trees blossoming, and our vibrant green rolling foothills. It's a very beautiful time of year. Where I live, the farmers are busy planting and growing their crops. Just the word springtime gives a feeling of great activity. We also have on March 9th, our clocks "springing" forward one hour for Daylight Saving Time.

Spiritually this is a time of renewing our faith. Many Christians around the world practice the Lenten Season. This year Lent begins on March 5th, and ends on the day before Easter Sunday April 19th. Lent is a spiritual practice of making a commitment to your spiritual life. Some fast by giving up foods, personal vices, luxuries, screen time. They also focus on their spiritual studies and practices of prayer and meditation, and may give time to being of service.

In Divine Science, our fasting is about giving up our negative thinking and judgments. I invite you to take up this practice during Lent this year, and witness the positive changes in your life. What do we put in place of all those habitual negative thoughts? We affirm truth, pray and meditate; we will find there is a lot less to say. We become more of a silent observer. We see life through the eyes of gratitude. We see the beauty and goodness that surrounds us. It's a change in attitude towards life. We can ask our Self, "How can I see this differently?" and "How can I best serve this situation?". The answer may just be to pray and meditate. The important thing is to be open to receive guidance. This can only be when we clear out our negative thinking and leave space to hear Divine Spirit speaking to us. Affirm: "I am decerning about the thoughts I entertain."

"Spring is a Time of Miracles" by Rev Teresa Stuefloten, M.Div.

It seems to me that nature brings about miracles every springtime. Trees that have had bare branches, appearing almost dead, begin to sprout bright green leaves and blossoms. The blossoming trees are so beautiful that people flock to places like Washington, DC to see the spectacle that nature puts on. Spring bulbs, like Tulips and Daffodils, spring up, seemingly out of nowhere, in dirt that has been completely bare. In my garden, bright orange California Poppies and Calendulas spring-up all by themselves from the seeds they dropped last summer. Mother Nature is a miracle worker! And gardeners everywhere are anxious to help her out, getting their hands in the dirt again, planting a garden.

We are miracles of God's creation. The following is a meditation I presented in the Sunday service on 2-2-25. I invite you to read the meditation and then close your eyes and go within to feel the words.

I invite you to get comfortable for a short time of meditation, closing your eyes and focusing on your breath. Gently follow your breath as you breathe in and out, not trying to change your breath, just feeling every part of the breath, the coolness of the in-breath and the warmth of the out-breath, as the breath brings you into the present moment. Nowhere to go, nothing to do, just resting in the present moment. Just be here now. In the present moment everything is fine.

I invite you to entertain the idea that you are a miracle. Say to yourself, "I am a miracle... I am a miracle." I am made in the image and likeness of my Creator. My soul is one with my Creator. When I agreed to incarnate on this earth plane, two tiny cells came together to begin to create my physical body. Those cells divided and continued to divide, according to a miraculous Divine Plan, creating organs, muscles, tissues, all according to a Divine blueprint.

My body was formed in my mother's womb according to a miraculous Divine blueprint. My brain, heart, lungs, stomach, intestines, liver, kidneys, eyes, ears, nose, mouth, muscles, arms, legs, skin, hair, all forming according to a miraculous Divine plan. As this miraculous body formed into the infant form, my consciousness slipped into this physical body to begin an earth plane life of living, learning, and growing spiritually. I am a miracule.

As I was born into this physical world, I was cared for by other Divine Expressions in the form of my family members. I grew physically and learned to love, to laugh, to roll over, to crawl, to walk, and to run. I went out in the world to learn, make friends, and grow to adulthood. And all the while my physical body continued to grow and change according to the Divine plan. I am a miracle.

Though I have an ego to function in the physical world, my soul is still my true identity, and always will be. I am a miracle. Tune in to your heart and feel that miracle. I am a Divine miracle... I am a Divine miracle. Now rest in your heart for a time of silence.

Now, having rested in the silence of your heart, I invite you to bring yourself back to the room you are sitting in, feeling gratitude for the silence, and for the knowledge that you are a living miracle, God in expression.
